

3-WAY TIE

PROCEDURE

- The total points scored (*only for and not against*) against all teams in the pool will be calculated.
- The average of the total scores is calculated.
- The teams are ranked in the descending order of their averages. (i.e, team with highest average is given highest rank)

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3-WAY TIE

Example: 4 teams A,B,C,D are in a pool. The teams have been given the following seeding

A - 4 B - 3 C - 2 D - 1

After all the 6 games in the league phase, teams A,B,D have won 2 games each resulting in a 3-WAY TIE.

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3-WAY TIE

Case 1: 3 Teams have different total scores

RESULT: Team with the highest **AVERAGE** is given highest rank

RESULT: Team with the highest **SEEDING** is given highest rank

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3-WAY TIE

RESULT: Winner in **HEAD-TO-HEAD** match is given highest rank

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
