DEFINITION:

- Game clock is stopped for an infraction (violation or foul)
- During this stopped period, additional infractions may happen.
- These are considered as Special Situations.

SPECIAL SITUATIONS




PROCEDURE:

- Identify the first infraction which stopped the game clock
- Determine the order of all infractions
- Identify the penalties of all infractions
- Cancel all infractions with equal penalties
- Administer remaining penalties in the order in which they were committed
- Resume the game



GENERAL FLOWCHART:





EQUAL PENALTY FOULS THAT CANCEL EACH OTHER

FOULS	PENALTY	
T_1 B_1 C_1 P_1	1 Free Throw	
B_2 U_2 D_2	2 Free Throws + Ball Possession	



ADMINISTERING REMAINING PENALTIES:

- Direct Technical Fouls (T_1, B_1, C_1) to be administered first
- Other fouls are to be administered in the order that they were committed
- Right to ball possession as part of last penalty will cancel any prior right to possession of the ball



GAME RESUMPTION:

- If last penalty involves ball possession, the game is to be resumed accordingly
- If all penalties cancel each other and at the time of the first infraction,
 - **❖** Valid field goal or last free throw is scored → Ball to non-scoring team
 - **❖** A team had control the ball or was entitled to the ball → Ball to same team
 - **❖** No team had control → Alternating Possession Arrow

SPECIAL SITUATIONS



EXAMPLE 1: A1 is dribbling the ball when offensive foul is charged on A1.

ORDER	FOUL	BY TEAM	PENALTY TO TEAM A	PENALTY TO TEAM B
1	OFFENSIVE (P)	Α	+	
2	TECHNICAL (T ₁)	Α	1FT	
3	UNSPORTSMANLIKE (U ₂)	В		2FT + P
4	DISQUALIFICATION (D ₂)	В		2FT + P
5	DISQUALIFICATION (B ₂)	Α	2FT + P	

^{*} FT – Free Throw, P – Ball Possession

- Possession of the ball as part of the last penalty (2FT + P) will cancel prior right to possession
 (P)
- 2. Technical Foul will be administered first. Team B receives 1 free throw.
- 3. Team A receives 2 free throws
- 4. Game will resume at the throw-in line in frontcourt as the last penalty involves ball possession

SPECIAL SITUATIONS



EXAMPLE 2: B1 steals the ball from A1 but does not gain control when A1 is charged with an Unsportsmanlike Foul.

ORDER	FOUL	BY TEAM	PENALTY TO TEAM A	PENALTY TO TEAM B
1	UNSPORTSMANLIKE (U2)	Α	2FT + P	
2	TECHNICAL (T ₁)	Α	-1FT-	
3	TECHNICAL (C ₁)	В		1FT
4	UNSPORTSMANLIKE (U ₂)	В		2FT + P
5	DISQUALIFICATION (D ₂)	Α	2FT + P	
6	DISQUALIFICATION (B ₂)	В		2FT + P

^{*} FT – Free Throw, P – Ball Possession

- 1. All penalties cancel each other and no penalties remain to be administered
- 2. Team A had control of the ball when A1 committed the first infraction. Hence Team A will be awarded the throw-in at the place of the first infraction with remaining time on the shot clock.
